2nd Annual IPM Day to be celebrated with planned gala and global eConference

New York, NY – October 31, 2006 — For the second consecutive year, global project management training company International Institute for Learning, Inc. In addition, IIL will be presenting a formal nighttime event entitled "Reaching the Summit: Achieving Greatness in Project Management," a project management awards ceremony reception and banquet, at Cipriani 23rd Street in New York City. Adventurer Peter Hillary, recognized for climbing Mt. Everest and reaching the South Pole overland, will be the keynote speaker. During his keynote, entitled "Climb Your Own Everest," he will passionately connect his dramatic achievements to the challenges faced by project managers and teams striving for excellence in their individual fields.

Dr. Kerzner will be honored in this year's event with the presentation of the first annual "Kerzner International Project Manager of the Year Award" to a project manager who has exemplified superior performance and outstanding project management methods, skills and techniques. This prestigious award will be co-presented by Dr. Kerzner and IIL President and CEO E. LaVerne Johnson to the winner, chosen from the six finalists who are being flown to New York. The winner will be officially presented with the award, a \$5000 voucher for any courses in IIL's training curriculum and a cash donation of \$3,000 to the winner's PMI chapter (if applicable).

"IPM Day was a great success last year, and we are delighted to make it even bigger and better this year. The entire day is planned with both global and local events," Johnson said. "Most of all, we want to recognize, appreciate, and celebrate project managers on this special day as well as on all other days of the year. One way we are doing this is by initiating and presenting the first annual Kerzner International Project Manager of the Year Award, and we are very excited both about honoring Dr. Kerzner and bestowing this award upon one very special project manager."

Many events around the globe are already in the implementation stage to celebrate the project management profession and recognize the contributions of project managers. For example, Mayor Michael R. Bloomberg will again officially proclaim November 2 as International Project Management Day throughout the City of New York. Other events are taking place in Australia, the UK and many more locations.
